- o Antenna Plan/ New Tower this is being incorporated with a plan to increase parking in the vicinity with a gravel lot. The county is reviewing the plan which was tentatively approved by the DFRC. It will result in about 18-20 spaces. We were given a ramp. Earthwork needs to be done which would be in conjunction with the antenna project and work around the clubhouse. There is an estimate of \$9,000 for the earthwork and another \$9,000 for the tower.
